Sunday Jun 30 Guildford - Prospect -Canley Vale - Liverpool

Grade: Easy – Medium **Start:** 9:00 am Guildford Railway Station (eastern side)

30km entirely riding along off-road cycle paths. Prospect canal cycle path and then undulating paths through Western Sydney Regional Park, the Orphans creek path to Canley Vale. Start: 9:00am from Liverpool Station. Unlimited car parking in Railway street on Sundays. An easy 35 km ride from Liverpool Station following bike paths through Lansvale, along Lake Gillawanna, Milperra & Kelso Park to Panania. Coffee stop before returning through Chipping Norton to Liverpool. Uses some roads.

Grade: Easy

Start: 9:00 am Liverpool Railway Station.

Unlimited parking in Railway Street on Sundays. Brownes Farm Reserve, at the end of First Avenue, Hoxton Park. A 20 km ride using SUPs and a few minor roads to join Liverpool Council's tree planting day. Council, with the help of volunteers, aims to plant local native trees, shrubs and ground covers to encourage native wildlife (by providing food and shelter) and to enhance the local area. Wear enclosed shoes, hat and sunscreen, and bring gardening gloves and a bike lock for peace of mind. Council will provide all tools, refreshments, and a free BBQ lunch. Grade: Easy-Medium Start: 9:00am. Wolli Creek Railway Station (Brodie Spark Drive.) 25km. Some cycleways, some on road, mostly flat with a couple of short rises. Basic confidence with on-road riding advisable. Explore the city and inner suburbs by bike. Advocacy News

Liverpool Council's Project for 2019 / 2020

About the middle of the year local governments produce their operational plans for the next financial year – this includes how much money council is planning to spend on cycleways. Sometimes there is not a lot of details apart from the \$ amount so LivBUG has followed up with Liverpool Council.

Council have reported back the major project for 2019 / 2020 is the Casula Rail Trail – connecting Casula Powerhouse to Leacock's Regional Park. The path will use a culvert under the rail line. Liverpool Council is leading the project which also involves the railway and national park agencies. LivBUG acknowledge Liverpool's council's efforts to make this happen and is a welcome project filling a long standing gap in one of regional cycle ways in Liverpool.



Newbridge Rd Path. One of the project over the past two years has been a shared user path along Newbridge Rd –is now completed from Georges River Bridge to Nuwarra Rd.



Cycleway Finder

<u>Cycleway finder</u> is a useful interactive online mapping tool provided by RMS – though it is not keeping up with the cycle route improvements that have been recently completed. LivBUG have sent in a number of the update recommendations for the paths that have been constructed in the last 2 years such as Newbridge Rd, sections of Hume Highway at Warwick Farm and Govern Macquarie Rd path upgrade.
